

SCHEDULE E: RENTAL INCOME & EXPENSES

This form is to assist you in organizing your rental information for your annual tax return. For an expense to be deductible, it must be considered an "ordinary and necessary" expense. You may include other applicable expenses. Per IRS regulations you must have written records of your rental expenses such as receipts, cleared or duplicate checks, and credit card statements for your purchases. You must keep a mileage log for all miles driven relating to your rental property.
